What is Collective Bargaining?

You've probably heard this term a lot over the past couple of years, but in Virginia, it's a process that (since a 1977 ban) two generations of workers have done without. Now that collective bargaining is legal in Virginia again, it's important to understand exactly what that means as an educator. The short answer is this: collective bargaining means the ability to negotiate our contracts. Contract negotiations mean better pay, better working conditions, and a higher level of professional dignity for <u>every</u> educator in Stafford County.
